He holds a Master's degree from Western Seminary in Portland, Oregon, and an earned doctorate from Dallas Theological Seminary in Dallas, Texas. Steve Farrar is the author of the best-selling book, *Point Man: How a Man Can Lead His Family*. With over 400,000 copies now in print, *Point Man* was the catalyst for his leaving the pastorate after 15 years and focusing his ministry on equipping men for spiritual leadership. Since the release of *Point Man* in 1990, Steve Farrar has also authored fifteen other books, including the best-selling *Finishing Strong*, *King Me*, and his newest release, *How To Ruin Your Life By Forty*. He is a frequent speaker for Men's Leadership Ministries conferences, Promise Keepers and many other events throughout the nation.
