This position works closely with other IT personnel to support the operation of the information systems infrastructure and its users.

Qualifications:

Education: Minimum of a bachelors degree. Degrees in computer science preferred.

Experience: The successful candidate will have a minimum of 1 to 3 years experience supporting technology in an educational setting. Experience with both Linux and Windows server operating systems, Moodle, single-signon or portal applications, and supporting a large number of users is highly desired.

Character: Candidates must have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ and evidence a mature Christian faith, be in agreement with the University's statement of faith, be committed to the integration of biblical principles in instruction and be willing to invest themselves in the development of faculty and students.
